In (Ps.27:14) the word "wait" is given twice so we know that all of us have a time waiting on the Lord sometimes. So in this time of physical healing it's hard to just wait for some parts of the body to get back to working order. I'm not in any physical therapy now but trying to do as much as I can to work and do things on my own. The doctors said it would take six months to a year to be healed but I believe I'm way ahead of that time.

The last two months have been getting back to walking and standing for longer periods of time to gain more strength back. I am now off of all medications and only take over the counter pain pills as needed. Praise the Lord for His faithfulness and healing in so many things. Though my left arm and hand is still with nerve damage it is getting better. Praise the Lord again!

In the last two months the Lord has given me three churches to preach and teach in for the first time since the accident. We have been able get back out on visitation with our home church also and visit some members in need. The work of ministry seems slow to me but our pastor and others say that we are doing what we can from where we've been. We are looking forward to getting back to doing much more as soon as possible.

There are two groups of people from two different churches that I've been counseling with to help them through a difficult time as they seek the Lord's will for their lives. It is not always easy to say what people need to hear verses what they want to hear. All pastors know what that is about when dealing with hurting or prideful folks. We certainly want what's best for everyone involved but we can only give advice and then it's up to them to do the rest. So we are still helping churches and pastors as much as we can with the Lord's help and grace.
